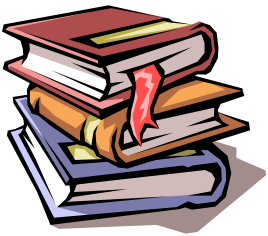


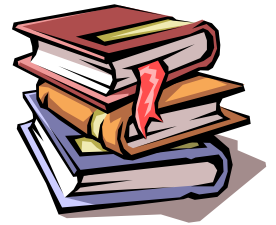
2014 MOCK ELECTIONS
